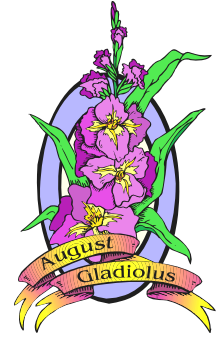
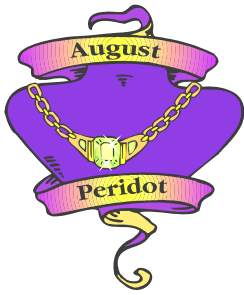

**Quarterly Financial Statements**

Your quarterly financial statements are on the glass table in the hall behind the Altar. Please pick your copy up and help the church to save on the postage. They are in alphabetical order for ease in finding yours. The church office is trying to be financially responsible with **YOUR** money so please pick up your copy from the table.



Did you know... NDSM gives rent and utility assistance to over 1200 households each year. Financial Aid is predicated upon an in-depth interview to assess the stability of the client, followed by verification of information including income, employment and address. NDSM provides clients with sufficient aid to reduce debt owed to zero, to give the client a fresh start.

As a member of North Dallas Shared Ministries our church has committed itself to providing volunteers to staff what is essentially an all volunteer agency of 500 serving 60,000 low-income North Dallas residents annually. While the mission statement of NDSM, to provide charitable assistance to persons in need, is directed at those seeking the food, clothing, financial assistance and medical care NDSM provides, it is apropos for those desirous of actualizing their faith. NDSM recognizes that all persons have needs; fortunately ours are less tangible, and NDSM is a wonderful place for meeting many of our needs.

Right now the NDSM Free Medical Clinic for the Uninsured needs physicians and dentists. Over the last two years the clinic has grown from five to eleven weekly clinics for adults and children and from acute and preventive care to the inclusion of chronic care. The twice monthly dental clinic is so oversubscribed that patients line up at 2:00 A.M. in hopes of having teeth pulled. Second year UT Southwestern medical students manage *The Monday Clinic*, a primary care, teaching clinic, and have initiated this plea for help.

As the med students say, "Volunteering in the clinic just one time monthly offers you the opportunity to teach, interact with medical students and other health care professionals, and lend a helping hand to sick people without the resources to take care of themselves." Flexibility is an NDSM trademark; NDSM pays for all medications and lab works as well as for malpractice insurance for its providers.

Please consider joining this remarkable ministry and/or recruiting others to do so; you may come to believe as most do that your rewards are greater than you can imagine. I have definitely found that to be true in my life.

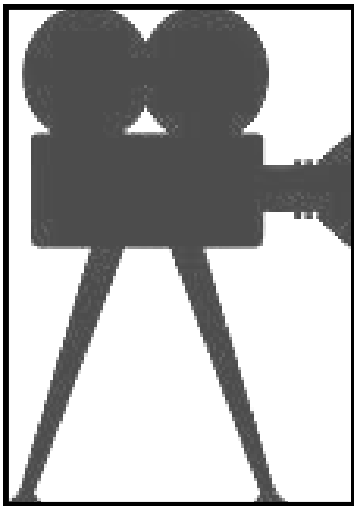
