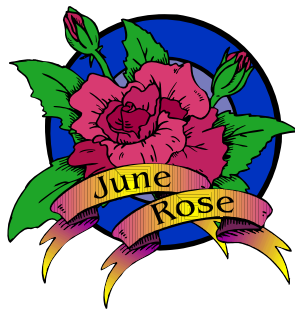

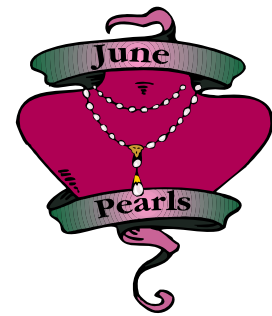

Time to gear up for Vacation Bible School!!!!

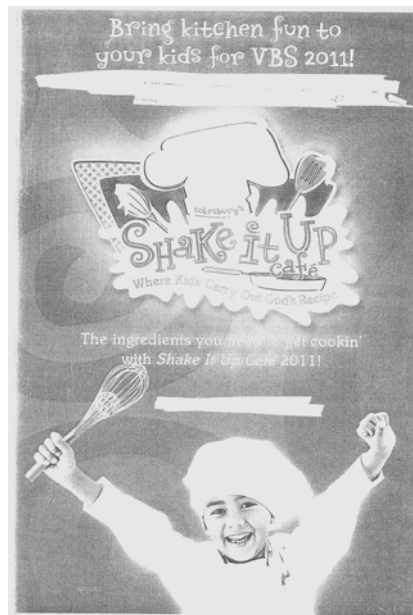
