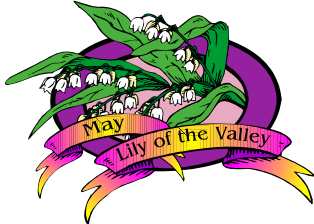
More UMW News
