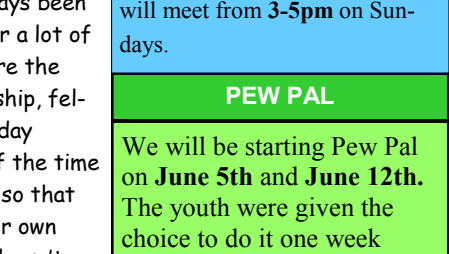
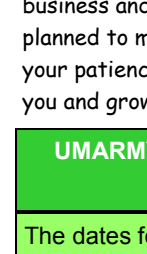

Starting on **June 5th**, the youth will meet from **3-5pm** on Sundays.

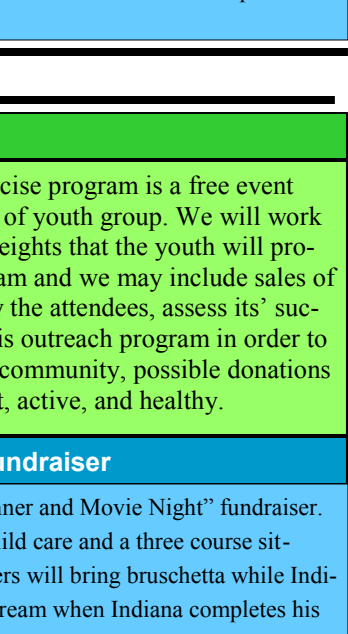
PEW PAL

The daily schedule for this camp is: morning devotion, breakfast, small groups split to do home repair/roof/siding/cleaning, lunch, finish at 4pm and shower at TX A&M University, evening activity (bowling/movie/talent show), closing worship, and spend night at 1st Methodist Commerce. Parent Meeting

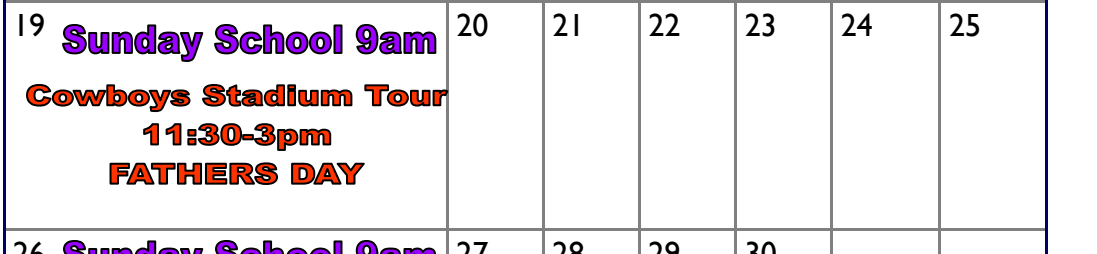
