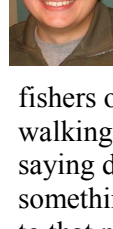
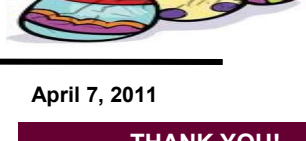


# Youth Newsletter



### To live in Jesus

In Mark 1:16-20 Jesus calls regular working people to come and help him in his ministry. "Come with me" he says "and I will make you fishers of people." Can you imagine that? Some man walking up to you while your at your job or school and saying great what your doing and I will help you do something great with your life. Imagine your response to that man. You might be curious, you might worry about his sanity, you might hope one of your friends walks by soon so that you could pretend he doesn't exist. Would you follow the examples of the disciples? When called would you drop everything and follow a man you'd never met? Probably not. We would want his credentials, his resume, who is he that we should follow him? What's he done himself that's great? If were going to give up our entire lives to follow someone we want to make sure its worth our time, worth our lives. Jesus is telling the disciples to give up everything and follow him. Essentially he's telling them that a life with him, Christ, is worth their lives. Following Jesus when he called wasn't hard for the disciples, that was the easy choice, they dropped their nets and immediately followed him. However for us in this day and this time following Christ is hard, not all of us hear that call. I challenge you however to reexamine what it means to be called by Christ. A call from Christ could simply mean being in the right place and the right time to do something good. When Jesus calls remember, Its worth your life.
